What do Parent Involvement Committees do?

The purpose of Parent Involvement Committees is to support, encourage and enhance meaningful parent involvement at the board level. The PIC acts as an advisory body to the board, and provides an important link between parents and the board's director of education and trustees. Parent Involvement Committees build parent engagement by:

- · providing information and advice to the board on parent engagement and communicating with parents
- · developing strategies and initiatives the board could use to engage more parents to support their children's learning at home and at school
- · sharing information with, and supporting the work of, school councils

Who is the Parent Involvement Committee?

The PIC membership is composed of:

- elementary and secondary parent representatives from each of the five geographical areas of the **Durham District School Board**
- · community members
- trustee members as appointed by the Board
- · board staff designated as a resource to the committee

PIC Meeting Dates

PIC meetings are held four times per year in the evening. Dates, times agendas and minutes are available on the DDSB website.

May I attend meetings?

The Durham District School Board PIC meets four times a year. Meetings are open to the public, and are held at the Durham District School Board Education Centre.
